Robert Philbrick and Susan Mulloy give COVID-19 updates:

Update given to the members on reopening plans and phases.

It appears likely that the Governor will allow outdoor dining only to start. Bob and Sue have spoken to the other licensing Boards asking them to allow outdoor dining temporarily in East Bridgewater (if the Governor doesn't do that himself). Everyone is in agreement that we can move forward with this plan.

M/Heger, s/Hubert, a unanimous vote to send letter to all restaurants asking them to submit proposals for outdoor dining locations and plans for review and approval by the BOH, Selectmen (alcohol) and Building Inspector.

Susan suggests the Board may want to extend Milk and Tobacco permits that were set to expire in June. Several of the stores have been closed during the pandemic and our department is already inundated with paperwork and follow-ups. M/Heger, s/Hubert a unanimous vote to extend all Milk and Tobacco permits through the end of the Calendar year and move to a Calendar year permit going forward.

Our Rabies Clinic is typically the first week of June. Due to the current limits on gatherings we haven't scheduled it yet. It typically coincides with dog licensing. We have spoken to the Vet about different safe immunization options. Before we move forward we will check and see of the Town Clerk can extend the licensing deadline.
