Board of Health Chairman, Peter Spagone, Jr. stated the reason for the meeting was to update the Selectmen with the Sewer Project.

Fran Yanuskiewicz from Weston & Sampson gave an update of the projects and due to no sewer commission in East Bridgewater the project falls under the purview of the Board of Selectmen.

DPW Director, John Haines stated the town needs to prepare for any businesses coming forward that want to connect to the treatment plant and have procedures in place.

Attorney John Clifford mentioned that this is a limited commodity. A criteria needs to be set up with the rules and regulations and an advisory group should be set up to work on the requirements and to make recommendations to the Selectmen.

There was some discussion in regards to the advisory group and the future possibility of phase 2 of the project.
