#### SELECTMAN'S REPORT

Selectman, David Sheedy discussed we will have a permanent Treasurer/Collector start date TBD. The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) is federal funding that the Town will receive. A committee was developed, and residents were asked to submit applications. This committee is designed to oversee how ARPA money is spent in town. 14 Residents submitted applications; this will be a 2–3 year commitment.
