Consideration and possible vote to increase number of days for in building learning for all students. Possible vote, or variation of the vote to be:

Transition from a hybrid learning model to an in-person learning model, effective February 10, 2021. Effective February 10, 2021 all educators and Cohort B students shall return to buildings on Wednesdays. The week of February 8th, Cohort B students shall be in-building February 10, 11 and 12.

The next Wednesday for which students will be in-building will be March 3rd and those students will be Cohort A. Unless otherwise voted by this Committee, in-building student attendance will alternate between Cohort A and Cohort B every other Wednesday.

Students who typically receive in-person and in-building instruction four days per week shall transition to a five day per week schedule effective February 10, 2021.

Effective Monday, March 1st students in grades K – 2 shall be in-person and in-building five days per week.

Any further shift to reopen buildings and increase student enrollment in the buildings shall be voted on by the Committee at a subsequent open session meeting.

Action Items:

Motion to transition from a hybrid learning model to an in-person learning model, effective February 10, 2021. The next Wednesday for which students will be in-building will be March 3rd and those students will be Cohort A. Unless otherwise voted by this Committee, in-building student attendance will alternate between Cohort A and Cohort B every other Wednesday.
