Mr. Sheedy led the Pledge of Allegiance.

## ACTION ITEMS

Mr. Seelig stated the town along with Town Counsel has been working on an intermunicipal agreement with the City of Brockton for a sewer connection to their wastewater treatment plant. Chris Kenny, Town Counsel has been working on the language for the agreement and seems satisfactory to both sides.

Mr. Seelig stated that after the Board of Selectmen sign the intermunicipal agreement it will then be brought to the City Council of Brockton for a first reading which should take place on March 28, 2022, then would refer to the Finance subcommittee for a meeting on April 4, 2022, if approved they would send the agreement back for the third reading to the City Council of Brockton meeting on April 11, 2022. The agreement, if approved will be brought to the mayor's office, the mayor has ten days to approve or deny the agreement. If approved, the Town of East Bridgewater would vote on a bond authorization for \$9,000,000.

Mr. Spagone Jr. thanked the team that has been working on this agreement, Charlie Seelig, John Haines; Fran Yanuskiewicz, Steve Pederson of Weston Sampson, and Chris Kenny for working diligently on the agreement. He stated this agreement for the sewer district is going to see huge benefits over the next 3-5 years.

Ms. Julius stated that she is excited to be part of the process.

Mr. Sheedy thanked everyone especially Peter Spagone Jr. for getting this agreement done.

Mr. Spagone Jr. made a motion to accept the intermunicipal agreement with the City of Brockton for a sewer connection to their wastewater treatment plant. Seconded by Ms. Julius. All were in favor. 3-0

Ms. Julius made a motion to approve the request from Professional Bartending Services for a One Day Liquor License for The Center at Sachem Rock for a Family Reception on March 20, 2022, from 2pm – 5pm. Seconded by Mr. Spagone Jr. All were in favor. 3-0
