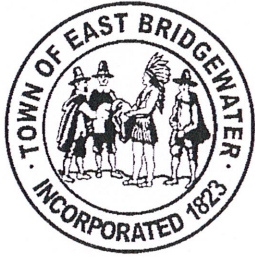

7:00 pm David Sheedy called the meeting to order.

Mr. Sheedy led the Pledge of Allegiance.

OPEN FORUM

Town Clerk, Susan Gillpatrick was present with a reminder that Dog Licenses are due September 1, 2021. After this time late fees will be assessed. If you have any question please call the Clerk's office 508-378-1606. Ms. Gillpatrick stated she is receiving actual numbers of the "2020 Federal Census" this week. She will present more information once received. Mr. Purcell questioned Ms. Gillpatrick regarding conflict between Municipalities and the State redrawing congressional lines with the census redistricting. Ms. Gillpatrick is not aware if the Town would be affected.

APPOINTMENTS

ACTION ITEMS

Ms. Julius made a motion to approve minutes of the July 19, 2021 7:00 pm Board of Selectmen's Meeting. Seconded by Mr. Spagone Jr. All were in favor. 3-0

Ms. Julius made a motion to approve but not release the minutes of the July 19, 2021 7:48 pm Board of Selectmen's Executive Session Meeting. Seconded by Mr. Spagone Jr. All were in favor. 3-0

Ms. Julius made a motion to approve street lighting requirements for Victory Lane and send to National Grid. Locations of two 17' Post Top Pole, Top LED luminaries are shown on the approved subdivision plan. The billing for these lights shall be established in the name of the developer until the Town of East Bridgewater accepts the street as a public way or until its accepted by the residential development association. Upon acceptance, and by request to National Grid, the company will process the billing change. Seconded by Mr. Spagone Jr. All were in favor. 3-0

Director of Public Works, John Haines was present to discuss streetlights. He stated the newer developments with underground utilities incorporates ornamental street lighting rather than a regular utility pole in their design plans. Mr. Haines stated working with the Planning Board the Town has adopted a particular streetlight style that will be acceptable between Town and developer. He stated National Grid would rent/lease these streetlight poles to the applicant then it would be turnover to the Town once approved.

Ms. Julius made a motion to approve the contract signing with Town Assessor, Paula Wolfe. Seconded by Mr. Spagone Jr. All were in favor. 3-0

Town Assessor, Paula Wolfe was present for her contract signing. The Selectmen commended her hard work and how

much Ms. Wolfe has done for the Town. Ms. Wolfe stated that she enjoys working for the Town of East Bridgewater and she has a great staff.

Ms. Julius made a motion to approve the Memorandum of Understanding, the General Teamsters, Chauffeurs, Warehousemen & Helpers of Brockton and Vicinity, Local Union No. 653 (the "Union") and the Town of East Bridgewater Department of Public Works. Seconded by Mr. Spagone Jr. All were in favor. 3-0

Director of Public Works, John Haines stated the agreement is directly related to the expansion of Wastewater Treatment Plant. He stated discussions held with the Financial Team determined services should be performed in house to manage and operate Wastewater Treatment Plant.

Ms. Julius made a motion to approve the Memorandum of Understanding between the Town of East Bridgewater and the Professional Firefighters Association. Seconded by Mr. Spagone Jr. All were in favor. 3-0

Paramedic, Matthew Foster was present to represent the Professional Firefighters Association. He thanked the Board of Selectmen on behalf of all the Firefighters, EMTs and Paramedics. Mr. Purcell briefly went over negotiations and MOU.

EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT

By and Between Town of East Bridgewater and James Patrick Purcell, Interim Town Administrator

THIS AGREEMENT, pursuant to Chapter 41, Section 108N of the Massachusetts General Laws, made and entered into this 5th day of April 2021 by and between the Town of East Bridgewater, Commonwealth of Massachusetts, a municipal corporation, hereinafter called the "Town", acting by and through its Board of Selectmen, hereinafter called the "Board", and James Patrick Purcell, _____, Massachusetts, _____ hereinafter "Mr. Purcell" or "Interim Town Administrator", as follows:

WITNESSETH:

Whereas, the Board of Selectmen desires to appoint Mr. Purcell to serve as Interim Town Administrator of the Town of East Bridgewater on an interim basis; and,

Whereas, the Board under Chapter 41, Section 108N of the Massachusetts General Laws, may contract with the Interim Town Administrator regarding his conditions of employment; and

Whereas, Mr. Purcell has agreed to accept the appointment as Interim Town Administrator of said Town.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

Section 1. Duties

- 1.1 The Town shall employ Mr. Purcell as the Interim Town Administrator. The Interim Town Administrator shall be responsible to, and work under the direction of the Board of Selectmen. His duties and responsibilities shall include, but are not limited to, those duties and responsibilities listed in the job description attached as Attachment A hereto. Further, the Interim Town Administrator shall perform any other legally permissible and proper duties and functions as the Board of Selectmen may from time-to-time assign.
- 1.2 Nothing in this Agreement shall prevent, limit, or otherwise interfere with the right of the Board to rescind the appointment of Interim Town Administrator.

Section 2. Indemnification

- 2.1 Employer shall provide indemnification and legal defense for the Employee in accordance with M.G.L. c. 258. To the extent not otherwise prohibited by law said indemnification and legal defense shall include any claim made following the expiration of the term of this agreement or the termination from employment of the Employee, so long as the Employer would have been otherwise obliged to provide indemnification and legal defense had the term not expired or the employment not have been terminated. Employee shall, as a condition of said indemnification and legal defense, cooperate with the Town, its attorneys and agents in all matters relating to said claim.
- 2.2 If the Interim Town Administrator leaves the employment of the Town and serves as a witness, he shall be paid for each day of preparation and attendance at a trial on a *per diem* basis based on his salary at the time of his separation from employment from the Town.
- 2.3 This Section shall survive the termination of this Agreement.

Section 3. Term, Minimum Hours and Compensation

3.1 This Agreement shall become effective April 5, 2021 and shall be in full force and effect until a permanent Town Administrator is appointed and prepared to take office or until the close of business on ~~June 30, 2021~~ whichever first occurs.

3.2 The Interim Town Administrator shall be responsible and have all authority of the Town Administrator as set forth in the Town Bylaws and shall be expected to perform to the standard expected of Town Administrators. Notwithstanding the foregoing, acknowledging that the appointment is a temporary appointment to serve on an interim basis it is expected by the Board of Selectmen and the Interim Town Administrator that the Interim Town Administrator will be able to fulfill these requirements in approximately twenty (20) to twenty-five (25) regular hours per week. If the Interim Town Administrator is required to work more than twenty-five (25) hours in a work week, he shall notify the Chairperson of the Board of Selectmen in advance of working such additional hours.

Given the professional nature of the position, it will be the responsibility of the Interim Town Administrator to determine his work schedule for the Town, although he will typically be in the Town offices three (3) days per week and attend night meetings.

3.3 The Town agrees that it shall pay the Interim Town Administrator at a rate of \$85.00 per hour for all regular hours worked, with usual deductions required by law. Given the professional nature of this position, it is expected that the Interim Town Administrator will monitor the business of the Town and be reachable beyond his regular offices per week and respond when necessary at no additional cost to the Town for these extra hours.

3.4 The Town agrees that it shall reimburse the Interim Town Administrator for any expenses related to his service to the Town consistent with its expense and mileage reimbursement policies. This Section shall survive the termination of this Agreement.

3.5 The Interim Town Administrator will be allowed two (2) weeks' vacation without pay. Unless provided for in its agreement, the Interim Town Administrator will not be entitled to any additional benefits.

3.6 Either the Board of Selectmen or the Interim Town Administrator may terminate this Agreement at any time, by providing forty-eight (48) hours-notice, in writing or by email to the other party.

Section 4. General Provisions

4.1 If any provision, or any portion thereof, contained in this Agreement, is held unconstitutional, invalid, unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement, or portion thereof, shall be deemed severable, shall not be affected, and shall remain in full force and effect.


4.2 This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the heirs at law executors of the Interim Town Administrator.

4.3 This Employment Agreement is entered into in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and shall be construed and interpreted in accordance with its laws.


4.4 The Interim Town Administrator warrants he has no public or private interest and shall not acquire directly or indirectly any such interest which would conflict with the providing of services.

THIS AGREEMENT, pursuant to Chapter 41, Section 108N of the Massachusetts General Laws, made and entered into this 30th day of August 2021 by and between the Town of East Bridgewater, Commonwealth of Massachusetts, a municipal corporation, hereinafter called the “Town”, acting by and through its Board of Selectmen, hereinafter called the “Board”, and Marilyn Thompson, hereinafter “Interim Treasurer Collector”, as follows:

WITNESSETH:

Whereas, the Board of Selectmen desires to appoint Ms. Thompson to serve as Interim Treasurer Collector of the Town of East Bridgewater on an interim basis; and,

Whereas, the Board under Chapter 41, Section 108N of the Massachusetts General Laws, may contract with the Interim Town Treasurer Collector regarding her conditions of employment; and

Whereas, Ms. Thompson has agreed to accept the appointment as Interim Treasurer Collector of said Town.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

Section 1. Duties

- 1.1 The Town shall employ Ms. Thompson as the Interim Treasurer Collector. The Interim Treasurer Collector shall be responsible to, and work under the direction of the Board of Selectmen through the Town Administrator. Her duties and responsibilities shall include, but are not limited to, those duties and responsibilities listed in the job description attached as Attachment A hereto. Further, the Interim Treasurer Collector shall perform any other legally permissible and proper duties and functions as the Board of Selectmen through the Town Administrator may from time-to-time assign.
- 1.2 Nothing in this Agreement shall prevent, limit, or otherwise interfere with the right of the Board to rescind the appointment of Interim Treasurer Collector.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, acknowledging that the appointment is a temporary appointment to serve on an interim basis it is expected by the Board of Selectmen and the Town Administrator that the Interim Treasurer Collector will be able to fulfill these requirements in approximately twenty (20) hours a week or less.

COLLECTOR / TREASURER

DEFINITION

Under the direction of the Director of Finance, manage Town financial operations involving billing and collections (property tax, motor vehicle excise tax, etc.), disbursement of funds (accounts payable, payroll, etc.), and short-term cash management.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Manage the distribution and collection of Town bills for quarterly property taxes, periodic motor vehicle taxes, and other Town services.

Supervise division staff in responding to customer questions and complaints regarding billing issues, and directly participate in resolving more complex or difficult customer service issues and problems.

Administer the progression of public collection activities, including demand billing, warranting, tax titles, liens and development/monitoring of payment plans.

Supervise the preparation and disbursement of Town payments for purchases, services, payroll, payroll taxes, employee benefits and the maintenance of related records.

Monitor and Oversee the preparation of various financial and accounting reports related to revenues, collections. Payroll, accounts payable disbursements, etc., and their reconciliation with the Town Accountant, Town department and banking records.

Oversee the Town's cash management program. Monitor cash levels, prepare cash flow projections for long- and short-term borrowing. Pay interest on maturing debt and prepare all papers for bond issues. Provide information to Moody's Rating Service for Town bond ratings and sign bonds, notes and other papers of credit for the Town.

Invest Town funds and maintain custody of securities for trust funds. Collect and account for income investments in fund portfolios and maintain custody of escrow accounts.

Supervise division staff and participate in their selection, evaluation and discipline in accordance with department and Town policies and procedures. Provide training, daily direction and counseling to staff as required.

Develop, implement, monitor and update division procedures and practices; work with Information Systems to resolve issues and upgrade division and related Town-wide systems.

Coordinate division operations with those of other Town departments and divisions.

Develop division budget request for submission to the Director of Finance; responsible for controlling division expenses within approved levels.

Coordinate other programs, such as Senior Tax Voucher program, Dollars for Scholars, and the Downtown Parking Sticker program.

Perform related duties as required.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITY

Supervise 4 or more full-time equivalent staff.

Normal office environment, not subject to extremes in temperature, noise, odors, etc.

**EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE TOWN OF EAST BRIDGEWATER
AND PATRICK FRANNEY, BUILDING COMMISSIONER**

This agreement ("the agreement") is entered into as of July 1, 2021 between the Town of East Bridgewater, Massachusetts (the "Town or Employer") And Patrick Franey ("Building Commissioner") in accordance with the provisions of General Laws, c. 143 § 3.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS the Board of Selectmen desires to employ the services of Patrick Franey as the Building Commissioner of the Town of East Bridgewater.

WHEREAS according to MGL, c. 143 § 3 The Board of Selectmen shall employ and designate a Building Commissioner for such services;

WHEREAS it is the desire of the Board to contract for the salary and benefits of said Building Commissioner;

WHEREAS it is the desire of the Board to retain the services of the commissioner, and to provide an inducement for him to remain in such employment; and

WHEREAS Patrick Franey agrees to accept continued employment as a Building Commissioner of said Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows;

Section I. Functions and Duties of the Building Commissioner

The Town hereby offers employment to Patrick Franey as a Building Commissioner of said town, and the Building Commissioner accepts said offer of employment.

The Building Commissioner shall be responsible for administering and enforcing the state building code as well as c. 21 § 13 and the rules and regulations made under the authority thereof. The Building Commissioner shall be under the general supervision of the Town Administrator and shall keep the Town Administrator informed regarding all projects, initiatives and serious issues that may arise. The Building Commissioner shall also be responsible for supervision of all staff assigned to or working in the Planning / Building Department, including but not limited to all employees of the Zoning Board, Planning Board, inspectors, and administrative staff. The Building Commissioner shall also be the lead facilitator of the Technical Review Committee.

The Building Commissioner shall be charged with the enforcement of the towns zoning bylaw's according to MGL c. 40 A §7.

The Building Commissioner shall be responsible for the operation of the Building Department.

Section II. Term

The terms of this agreement shall commence on July 1, 2021. The terms and conditions of this agreement shall remain in force and effect until June 30, 2024.

Section III. Separation / Non-Renewal

The Town may terminate the service of the Building Commissioner at any time for cause. "Cause" under this Agreement shall be defined as a failure to meet performance goals as described below or serious misconduct in violation of any law or Town policy, whether such misconduct occurs on or off duty.

In the event the Building Commissioner voluntarily resigns his position with the Town before the expiration of the term of employment provided for herein, then he shall give the Town 90 days in advance notice unless the parties agree otherwise.

The Board of Selectmen will provide written notification as provided herein to the Building Commissioner, 90 days before the end of the contract period. If the board of selectmen does not intend to renew this agreement with the terms, conditions, compensation, and benefits, equal to or exceeding this agreement.

The Board of Selectmen and Building Commissioner, if mutually agreed, shall enter into negotiations for the terms of a new contract (4) months prior to the expiration of this contract.

Section IV. Salary

- A. The Town agrees to pay the Building Commissioner for services rendered under this agreement, an annual base salary of \$87,167 subject to applicable withholdings and deductions effective July 1, 2021 and continuing through June 30, 2022. Payable in installments at the same time as other employees of the town are paid.
- B. The Town agrees to pay the Building Commissioner for services rendered under this agreement, an annual base salary of \$88,910, reflecting a 2% increase over the prior fiscal year. In addition to this increase, the Building Commissioner shall be eligible to receive an additional 3% increase in annual base salary on July 1,

2022, if he meets performance goals and standards established by the Town Administrator. Subject to applicable withholdings and deductions effective July 1, 2022 and continuing through June 30, 2023, Payable in installments at the same time as other employees of the town are paid.

- C. The Town agrees to pay the Building Commissioner for services rendered under this agreement, an annual base salary increase of 2% over the prior fiscal year. Subject to applicable withholdings and deductions effective July 1, 2023 and continuing through June 30, 2024, Payable in installments at the same time as other employees of the town are paid.

Section V. Hours of Work

Building Commissioner agrees to devote the amount of time and energy which he determines is reasonably necessary for the Building Commissioner to faithfully perform the duties of the Building Commissioner under and within his contract. Due to the unique nature of the Building Department function, it is understood and agreed that in order to properly perform the job required, the Building Commissioner may have to expend additional time beyond the normal workday, and the Building Commissioner agrees to do the same as required. It is acknowledged that the position is one of an Executive/Administrative nature as that term is used in the Fair Labor Standards Act, it's rules and regulations. There shall be no paid overtime or additional compensation for said additional time.

However, the Building Commissioner may adjust his schedule taking into account such extra time as long as the same does not interfere with the obligations to perform his duties. No "compensatory" time may be accrued.

Section VI. Health insurance, Vacation, Holidays, Sick Leave, Funeral Leave, and Disability

- A. The Town shall provide the Building Commissioner a health insurance policy, similar to other Town employees. The Town shall pay the percentage of the premium, and the Building Commissioner shall pay the portion of the premium in accordance with the policy the Building Commissioner shall select from those offered by the town under the group insurance commission.
- B. The Building Commissioner is eligible for the health insurance plan and if decides to waive participation shall receive an annual stipend of \$1500.
- C. The Building Commissioner shall be granted (15) days paid vacation per contract year. The Building Commissioner shall be allowed to carry over any unused portion or submit for reimbursement up to five days of unused vacation time remaining to his credit. If the Building Commissioner has accrued more than (5)

days of unused vacation time, he may apply to the appointing authority for approval to carry over or submit for reimbursement a greater amount of unused time.

- D. Building Commissioner shall receive the same holiday, sick leave, personal time and emergency leave as specified in the personnel By-Laws of the Town.
- E. Upon the death or retirement of the Employee, his estate, in addition to all the other benefits, shall be paid for all accrued vacation leave as calculated as of the last day of his retirement or death and at his then applicable rate. Upon death or retirement of the Employee, the Town shall compensate the Employee or his estate for unused sick leave, according to the language of this agreement.

Section VII. Professional Development / Expenses

- A. The Town shall pay costs related to appropriate continuing education and professional development licensure and certifications. The Town shall pay costs related to education courses, seminars, and meetings as deemed appropriate to the position of Building Commissioner and subject to the approval of the Town Administrator and available funding. The Town shall pay annual membership dues for applicable professional organizations and affiliations.
- B. Time with pay shall be given to the Building Commissioner to allow participation in appropriate Building related meetings, conferences, association memberships, and programs or any other organizational participation or training as the Town Administrator shall approve. Funds will be budgeted each year to cover the Building Commissioners expense in attending such events. It is understood that the funds available may not cover the full cost of attending given program, and that, in some cases, no funds available.
- C. The Town shall reimburse the Patrick Franey, Building Commissioner four hundred dollars (\$400) per quarter (total of a \$1600 per year) for work related milage and use of his personal truck for Town business.

VIII. Indemnification

The Town shall provide indemnification in legal defense for the Building Commissioner in accordance with the general laws, C. 258. To the extent not otherwise prohibited by the law said indemnification in legal defense shall include any claim made following the expiration of the term of this agreement or the termination from employment of the Building Commissioner, so long as the Town should have been otherwise obligated to provide indemnification in legal defense Had the term not expired or employment not have been terminated. The Building Commissioner shall, as a condition of said indemnification and other legal defense, cooperate with the town,

it's attorneys and agents in all the matters relating to said claim. The Town, during the term of agreement, will maintain adequate professional liability insurance for the employee in connection with his performance of duties as the Building Commissioner. (This provision shall survive any termination of this agreement concerning acts or omissions while serving as a Building Commissioner.)

IX. Other Benefits

- A. This agreement shall constitute the entire Agreement between the parties except to the extent that other documents are referred herein, which documents shall be deemed to be incorporated by reference herein.
- B. This agreement shall prevail over any conflicting personnel provisions of the Town Bylaws.

X. Notices

Notices pursuant to this agreement may be personally served. Notice shall be deemed given as of the date of personal service or as of the date of deposit of such written notice in the course of transmission in the United States Postal Service. under this Agreement shall be given by deposit in the custody of the United States Postal Service, postage prepaid, addressed as follows:

XI: General Provisions.

- A. The text herein shall constitute the entire agreement between the parties.
- B. The Building Commissioner and the Board of Selectmen agree that this agreement supersedes the Town's Personnel Bylaw.
- C. If any provision, or any portion thereof, contained in the agreement is held unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable, the remainder of this agreement, or part or portion thereof, shall be deemed severable, shall not be affected, and shall remain in full force and effect.

D. For the purposes of the Fair Labor Standards Act, the Building Commissioner shall be an "exempt employee."





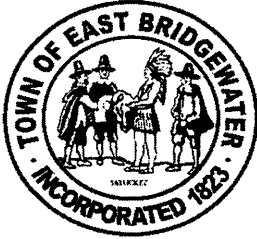

WITNESS THESE PRESENTS THAT I, Ousamequin, Sachem of the country of Poconocket, having given, granted, enfeofed, and sold unto Mile Standish, of Duxbury, Samuel Nash and Constant Southworth of Duxbury aforesaid, in behalf of all the townspeople of Duxbury aforesaid, a tract of land usually called Satucket, extending in length and breadth thereof, as followeth, that is to say, from the wear on Satucket seven miles due east, and from said wear seven miles due west, and from the said wear seven miles due north, and from the said wear seven miles due south, the which tract the said Ousamequin hath given, granted, enfeofed and sold unto the said Miles Standish, Samuel Nash and Constant Southworth in behalf of all the townsmen of Duxbury as aforesaid, with all the immunities, privileges, and profits whatsoever belonging to the said tract of land, with all and singular all woods, underwoods, lands, meadows, rivers, brooks, rivulets, &c, to have and to hold to the said Miles Standish, Samuel Nash and Constant Southworth in behalf of all the townsmen of the town of Duxbury, to them and their heirs forever. In witness whereof I, the said Ousamequin, have hereunto set my hand this 23rd day of March 1649.

WHEREAS, an increase in the overall suicide rate in our country was seen in 2019, representing a change in the recent pattern of stability or slight declines,

WHEREAS, suicide is a community problem and thus there must be a community response through various initiatives to reduce suicidal behaviors;

WHEREAS, The Plymouth Suicide Prevention Coalition, which is dedicated to reducing the frequency of suicide attempts and deaths through education, awareness and action, urge that we as a community:

1. Recognize suicide as a national, state and Hull public health problem and declare suicide prevention to be a Plymouth County priority;
2. Acknowledge that no single suicide prevention program or effort will be appropriate for all populations or communities;
3. Encourage local initiatives based on the goals contained in the *National Strategy for Suicide Prevention* that will,
 - a. Develop and implement strategies to reduce the stigma associated with being a consumer of mental health, substance abuse, and suicide prevention services.
 - b. Develop and implement community-based suicide prevention programs and suicide bereavement support services.
 - c. Implement training for the recognition of at-risk behavior and for the delivery of the effective treatment.
 - d. Increase access to, and community linkages with, mental health and substance abuse in the entertainment and news media.

WHEREAS, a great many suicides are preventable; THEREFORE, IT BE RESOLVED that, we, the East Bridgewater Board of Selectmen do hereby designate September 10th, 2021, which overlaps World Suicide Prevention Day on September 10th, as "National Suicide Prevention Month" in the Town of East Bridgewater, Massachusetts.

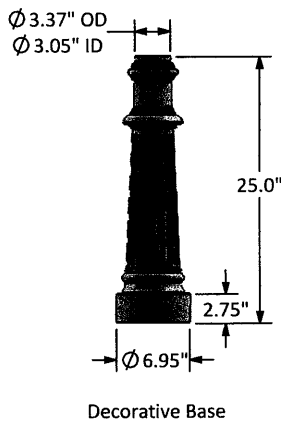
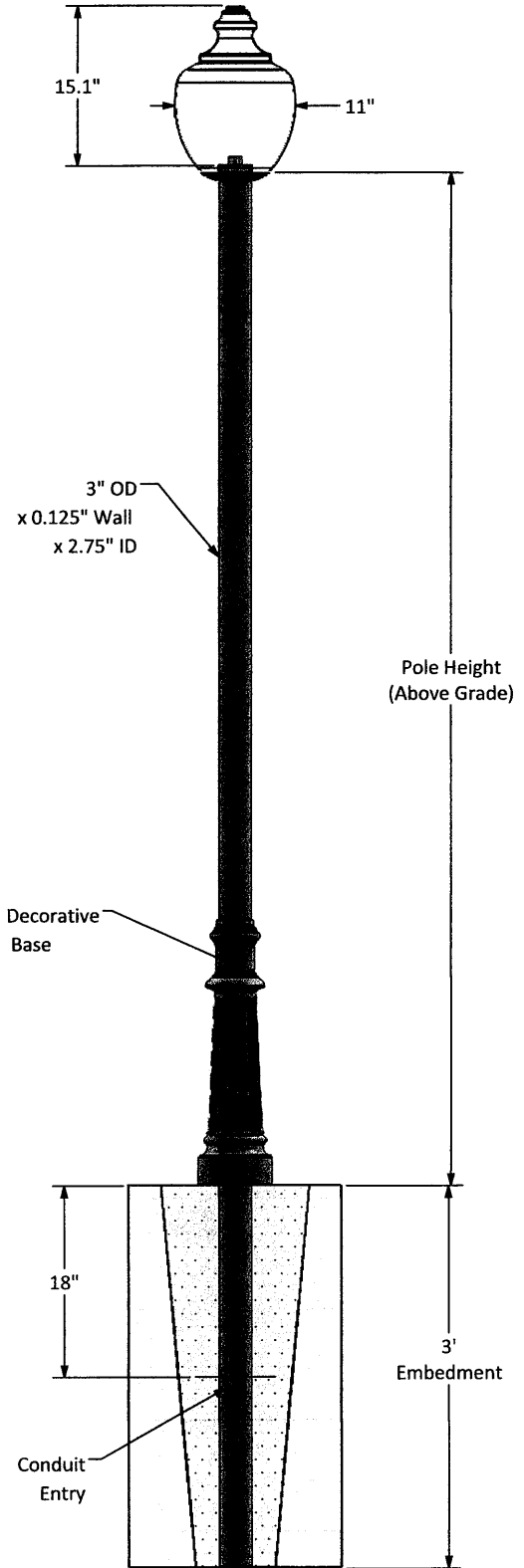
