The Tree worker classification will also be added into the Union so in the future on can be hired. Mr. Noble stated it was a very amendable negotiation.

Mr. Noble and the Selectmen had a discussion regarding Treasurer / Collector, Melissa Morrissey upcoming contract. Mr. Noble stated he is very pleased with the work she is doing. He would like to propose an increase of \$1,000.00 plus a 2%, 2%, 2%.
