OFFICE OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH TOWN OF EAST BRIDGEWATER

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November 6, 2023

The Board of Health (BOH) held a meeting at the Town of East Bridgewater Town Offices, 175 Central Street, East Bridgewater, MA in Conference Room First Floor. BOH Members present Robert Lyons (RL) Chair, Tom Duquette Jr. (TD) Vice Chair and Clerk. Also in attendance, Jeanmarie Joyce, (JJ), Health Agent and Sandra Abban (SA) Administrative Assistant. Absent, Andrew Hudson (AH).

RL called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM and stated there are no hearings and no appointments.

TD made a motion to enter into Executive Session and to return to open session for the purpose of Pursuant to MGL Chapter c. 30A, § 21 (8) To consider or interview applicants for employment or appointment by a preliminary screening committee if the chair declares that an open meeting will have a detrimental effect in obtaining qualified applicants; provided, however, that this clause shall not apply to any meeting, including meetings of a preliminary screening committee, to consider and interview applicants who have passed a prior preliminary screening; RL seconded the motion. So, voted.

Open meeting came back into session at 5:20pm.

Action Items:

Approval of Bills

TD made a motion to approve Brown and Caldwell, Invoice #9649517, Amount \$1,750.00; Description – Professional Services Bridge - St Landfill Monitoring. RL seconded the motion. So, voted.

TD made a motion to approve Crystal Rock, Invoice #1016063012123, Amount \$10.58, water - Scott Johnson Land Clearing, Invoice #2831, Amount \$7,700.00 – Bridge St Landfill Project - B&D Associates, Inc. – Invoice #36142, Amount \$240.00 – Medical waste pick up 3 boxes. RL seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Approval of Minutes

Not voted on.

Disposal System Construction Permits

RL made a motion to accept as submitted **42 Trudeau Lane, East Bridgewater** – 310 CMR 15.212 of the State Sanitary Code which requires a minimum 4' vertical separation between the high ground water elevation and the bottom of the soil absorption system with a percolation rate greater than 2 minutes per inch. A local upgrade approval allowing a reduction from 4' to 3' is required. DEP Policy #BRP/DWM/PeP-POO-1, allowing a percolation rate to be established via grain size distribution analysis is requested. TD seconded the motion. So, voted.

RL made a motion to accept as submitted **720 Harvard Street, East Bridgewater – 310 CMR 15.212** of the State Sanitary Code which requires a minimum 4' vertical separation between the high groundwater elevation and the bottom of the soil absorption system with a percolation rate greater than 2 minutes per inch. A local upgrade approval allowing a reduction from 4' to 3' is requested. **DEP Policy #BRP/DWM/PeP-POO-1,** allowing a percolation rate to be established via grain size distribution analysis is requested. **310 CMR 15.211** of the State Sanitary Code which requires a minimum 10' setback from a foundation wall to a septic tank. A local upgrade approval allowing a reduction from 10' to a minimum of 6' is requested (for tight tank, to avoid vehicle traffic). TD seconded the motion. So, voted.

RL made a motion to accept as submitted **243 Whitman St, East Bridgewater** – 15.405(1)(h) reduction in separation between bottom of soil absorption system and the high groundwater from the required 4ft. to 3ft. 15.405(1)(i) a sieve analysis may be performed in accordance with Department guidance if a percolation test cannot be performed. 15.405(1)(j) reduction of the requirement of a 12-inch separation between inlet and outlet trees and high groundwater. TD seconded the motion. So, voted.

New Construction

JJ stated **505 North Central St, Lot 1** –The East Bridgewater Board of Health did not approve the plans dated October 19, 2023. The plans as submitted required variances from 310 CMR 15.

- 220(4)h(l). which require 2 observation hole in the main system and 2 observation holes in the reserve area.
- .220(4)b requiring a scale of 1=20 in the area of the components.
- .220(4)q requiring a benchmark within 50-75 feet of the system
