- 6. <u>Emerging Public Health Concerns-</u> DPH announced that there is a Hepatitis A Outbreak on the south shore with 6 cases in the last 2 weeks of November. None detected locally. Hepatis A is viral, and contagious through intimate contact and food handling route .It has a 2-3 incubation period and is primarily in homeless individuals, drug users and those with a compromised immune system. Our major focus is on food handlers. *Sanitizer is not effective against Hep A, only hand washing.*

Flu, Covid and SSR are increasing(as expected). Free Covid test kits with an expiration date of February 2024 are available in the BOH office.
