Clerk Julius announced the Selectmen were entering into Executive Session Pursuant to MGL Chapter 30A, § 21 (a)(2) To conduct strategy sessions in preparation for negotiations with nonunion personnel, Treasurer / Collector, and to conduct contract negotiations with nonunion personnel, Treasurer / Collector and will not return to open session.

Mr. Sheedy made a motion to move into Executive Session, Mr. Spagone Jr. seconded. Roll Call Vote: Mr. Sheedy: Aye, Mr. Spagone Jr: Aye, Ms. Julius: Aye. All were in favor, 3-0

Mr. Seelig stated he will need to make a counter offer to Treasure Collector candidate Pamela Adduci. The Board of Selectmen originally recommended an offer of \$82,000 annually with a 1,000 stipend to keep her Certified Massachusetts and Treasurer certificates current through the Massachusetts Collectors & Treasurers Association.

Mr. Seelig stated that Ms. Adduci countered at \$95,000 with a \$3,000 stipend. The Selectmen's office did a salary survey by reaching out to communities of similar size. Mr. Seelig stated that the average was \$93,000.

The Selectmen agreed that \$93,000 would be a fair counter which would include her maintaining her Certified Massachusetts and Treasurer certificates current through the Massachusetts Collectors & Treasurers Association. Mr. Seelig stated he will reach out to Ms. Adduci and make the offer.

Ms. Julius made a motion to adjourn from Executive Session at 10:30 am, seconded Mr. Spagone Jr. All were in favor, 3-0
