### **Meeting Minutes May 28, 2022**

There will be increased patrols and more monitoring of activity in the area. Detective Jenkins encouraged all coaches & parents to call police department any time there is an issue so it can be addressed at the time of incident, such as when a phone was taken. Contact to be made to youth sports to advise all coaches of this. Suggestion was made to board up dugouts for winter.

Cameras and surveillance will be priced and looked into for all areas. Signage will be posted to alert the public to camera use.
