BALLOT QUESTION

"Shall the Town's acceptance of Chapter 31 of the General Laws (Civil Service law) be revoked for the rank of Sergeants, Reserve Patrolmen, and Regular Patrolmen, within the Police Department?"

SUMMARY: Sergeants, Reserve Patrolmen, and Regular Patrolmen within the Police Department are currently subject to the state Civil Service laws, which govern matters such as original appointments, promotions, and termination from employment. This ballot question would revoke the town's acceptance of General Laws Chapter 31, the state Civil Service statute, for the rank of Sergeants, Reserve Patrolmen, and Regular Patrolmen within the Police Department. However, current members of the department in that rank will remain covered by the statute's protections.
