All voters enter from the Gym/Auditorium entrance.

Precincts 1,2,3 & 4 – vote in the gym.

# Vote By Mail –

All registered voters qualify to vote by mail.

[APPLY EARLY](#) for Vote by Mail to ensure ample time for processing your application and for the postal services to deliver your ballot. This proactive step will help you participate in the election without any last-minute rush. If you are concerned about applying too early - please note that voters can hold on to their ballot and return it the week before the election in the secure ballot drop box outside of the Town Offices. Voters who receive a vote-by-mail ballot and have not returned it may appear to vote in person on election day to cast a ballot. Any voter who has returned a vote by mail ballot cannot vote on Election Day. [Application Here](#).

## [RETURN OF VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS](#)

Once you receive your ballot, please vote promptly, place the ballot in the manila ballot envelope, and sign the required affidavit. Then, place the sealed ballot envelope in the postage-paid white return envelope and return it by U.S. mail or in the secure ballot drop box at Town Hall 175 Central St. Rest assured, the Town Clerk's staff will process your returned ballot on Election Day and bring it to the polls to be cast, ensuring the integrity of your vote.

Ballots can NOT be returned to the polling location on Election Day—they must be returned to the secure ballot drop box at the Town Hall. The Town Clerk's staff will process your returned ballot on Election Day and bring it to the polls to be cast.

Deadlines for ballots to be returned and counted.

Ballots returned in the secure ballot drop box must be received by **7 PM** on **May 18<sup>th</sup>**.

Ballots returned by mail must be **RECEIVED** by the Town Clerk by **7 PM** on **May 18<sup>th</sup>**.

\*\*Please note that US Postal delivery services are inconsistent and can range from 3 to 11 days. We recommend voters return their ballots in the secure ballot drop box outside the Town Offices by 7 PM on Election Day to ensure it is counted.
